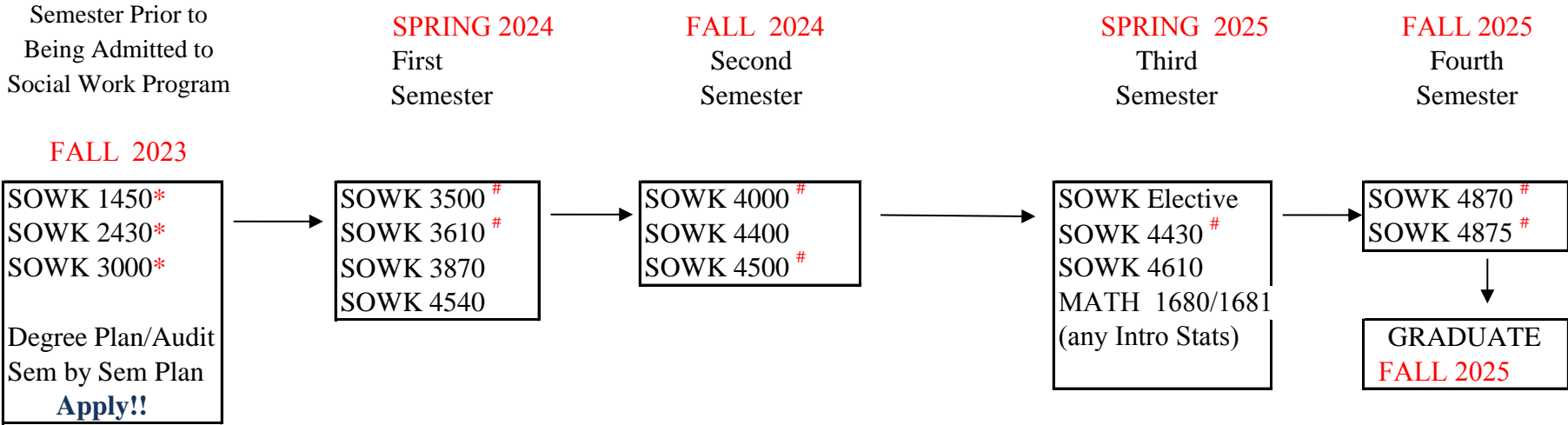


Flow Chart of How Social Work Majors Move Through UNT's Social Work Program
